WINNING TICKET WORTH \$200,000 SOLD IN NORTH DAKOTA

You might be \$200,000 richer and not even know it. Another winning Powerball ticket purchased for the draw on Wednesday, May 12, 2010 matched all five white balls for a prize worth \$200,000. The winning ticket was sold at the Northport Hornbacher's in Fargo, located at 2510 North Broadway. The winning white numbers for this match five prize are: 37, 51, 52, 53, and 58.

This is now the third winning Powerball ticket sold in North Dakota since January, 2010 that matched all five white balls for a prize worth \$200,000 – all of which remain unclaimed – and the winners are on the clock to beat the 180-day deadline for claiming their \$200,000 prize.

“If you have the winning ticket, be sure to sign the back of it and then call the North Dakota Lottery right away to make arrangements to claim the prize,” said Randy Miller, director of the ND Lottery.

One ticket, purchased for the January 9 draw, was sold at Stamart located at 1340 34th St SW in Fargo. The deadline to claim that ticket is July 8, when the ticket must be presented to the Lottery. Another winning ticket, purchased for the draw on April 21, was sold at Pony Express Conoco located at 1020 S. Washington Street in Bismarck. Each Powerball ticket matched all five white balls for the \$200,000 prize and would have been worth \$1 million if the Power Play option had been purchased with the ticket.

Winners have 180 days from the date of the drawing to claim a prize. Prizes that are not claimed within that time are transferred to the North Dakota General Fund. Players can check for winning numbers by visiting a participating Lottery retailer or visiting the Lottery's website at www.lottery.nd.gov, or by calling the winning numbers line at 701-328-1111.
