MILLION DOLLAR POWERBALL TICKET SOLD IN JAMESTOWN

BISMARCK, ND – A Powerball ticket purchased in North Dakota for the draw last night, April 20, 2016, matched all five white balls, making it worth \$1 million. The winning numbers are 12, 25, 30, 52, 62, and the Powerball is 8. The Power Play multiplier is 3. No one has come forward yet to claim the prize.

The lucky ticket was sold at Dan's Sooper Stop, 811 13th Street NE, in Jamestown. The store will receive a \$5,000 bonus for selling the winning Powerball ticket.

"We are extremely excited to have been the only lottery to have a Match 5 Powerball winner in last night's draw, the only lottery out of forty-seven. If you have the winning ticket, the first thing you should do is sign the back of the ticket," said Randy Miller, director of the North Dakota Lottery. Winners have 180 days from the date of the drawing to claim their prize.

The Powerball jackpot for the Saturday, April 23 draw is \$251 million. For winning numbers and other information, visit LOTTERY.ND.GOV.
