\$100,000 POWERBALL PRIZE REMAINS UNCLAIMED

Bismarck – A North Dakota Powerball ticket from the October 24, 2018 draw remains unclaimed, and the winner is almost out of time to claim the prize. The \$100,000 ticket expires on April 22, 2019.

Winners have 180 days from the date of the drawing to claim their prize, after which the prize is eventually returned to the State General Fund. No one has contacted the Lottery office to claim the prize.

The lucky ticket was sold between October 21 and October 24, 2018 at the Holiday Stationstore #418, 2755 Brandt Drive, in Fargo. The ticket won by matching four white balls and the Powerball. The winning numbers were 3, 21, 45, 53, 56 and the Powerball was 22. The Power Play multiplier was 2. The prize was \$50,000, but as the player had also purchased the Power Play option, the prize doubled to \$100,000.

"This is a large prize to not have been claimed as of yet," said Randy Miller, director of the North Dakota Lottery. "We are doing everything we can to alert the public that this prize is still unclaimed. We encourage players to promptly check their tickets."
